PRAYER FOR A NEW SCHOOL YEAR

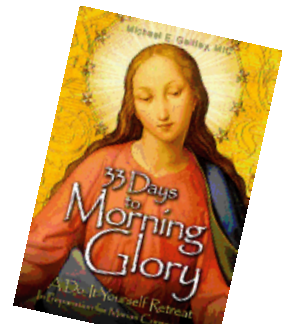
